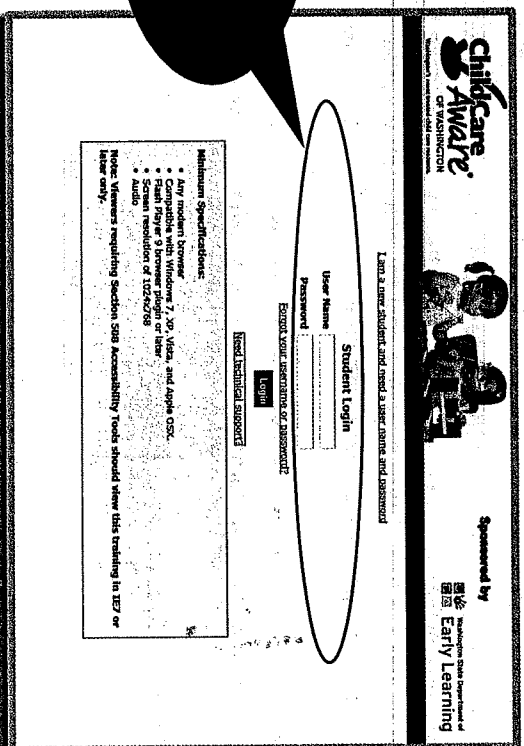


## Online Trainings

The Early Achievers Online Trainings will help you get familiar with some of the main Early Achievers concepts. To begin, you must first register online. Here's how:

1. Go to <http://cca.deltraining.com/> and create your account. We recommend using the Google Chrome, Firefox or Safari web browsers.

2. Once you complete and submit your new student registration, a welcome message will appear.
3. The next step is to enroll in your online trainings. Click the link at the end of the welcome message to get to the course catalog. Select the Early Achievers Level 2 Online Training link. This will enroll you in all three of the online classes, and an optional Early Achievers Health Training.



**Program Name:** Early Achievers, Level 2 Online Training (English) - click to enroll

**Description:** This is the series of three free online courses required as part of Level 2 of Early Achievers. In addition to completing all three of these trainings online, Early Achiever participants must also complete a series of three free trainings in person. Please contact your TA Specialist for details on these 6 required trainings.

**Courses in program:** Early Learning Guidelines (English) - Online - CORE COMPETENCY: Professional Development and Leadership; 2 STARS hours. This course is an introductory overview of the Washington State Early Learning and Development Guidelines, which can help orient adults to child development. The module examines the history and purpose of the Guidelines and who can use Guidelines and for what purpose. Additionally, the module provides an overview of the structure of the 2012 ELGs document and presents examples of how to use the Guidelines to support child development.

Care Competency for Providers (English) - Online - CORE COMPETENCY: Professional Development and Leadership; 2 STARS hours. This course is an introductory overview of the Core Competencies. The goal of this course is to help professional providers who care for children 0-8 in the state of Washington become familiar with the Core Competencies for Early Care and Education Professionals.

Introduction to ERS/GLASS (English) - Online - CORE COMPETENCY: Curriculum and Learning Environment; 1 STARS hour. Interactions; 1 STARS hour. Total STARS Hours: 2. This course provided an overview of the two standardized assessments used in Early Achievers as part of the comprehensive measure of program quality reflected in the rating. The focus of the ERS is on safety, organization and the age-appropriateness of daily schedule and materials within the environment. The CLASS focuses on teacher-child interactions as a means to promote children's social and cognitive development. Together these two assessments provide a comprehensive measure of the learning environment.

4. Once you confirm your enrollment, you will arrive at your home page. The next time you log in, you will go directly to your home page. From here, you can begin your classes.

*Suggestion: Encourage your staff to take the online trainings. They are free, earn STARS credit and are a great way to introduce Early Achievers concepts.*
